**Columbia, S.C.** – South Carolina Attorney General Henry McMaster and the Gang Prevention Study Committee, created by the General Assembly in the 2007 Criminal Gang Prevention Act, will hold a regional meeting at **4:30 p.m.** in Greenville, South Carolina, on **Thursday, August 27, 2009.**

The meeting will be held at **County Square, Conference Room B, located at 301 University Ridge in Greenville,** South Carolina, 29601.

The Gang Prevention Study Committee was established to study and keep abreast of issues and problems concerning criminal gang activity in South Carolina. The committee has met a number of times to discuss and develop strategies for combating the state's problems posed by criminal gangs.
