## **McMaster to Make Major Internet Predator Announcement This Week**

Columbia, S.C. – Attorney General Henry McMaster has invited the law enforcement agencies that are members of his statewide Internet Crimes Against Children (ICAC) Task Force to join him at **10:30 a.m. on Wednesday, September 2, 2009**, when he will announce two (2) major milestones in the state's battle against Internet Child Predators.

The announcement will be held at the Attorney General's Office, located in the Rembert Dennis Building on the State House complex in Columbia.

McMaster will provide the media with a complete overview of the work of the Task Force since undercover Internet sting operations began in April of 2004.

Since his effort to expand the Task Force in 2005, McMaster has built an expansive team of law enforcement agencies to pursue Internet Child Predators in South Carolina.

The Task Force has announced one hundred seventy (170) arrests since the Internet Child Predator law was passed in 2004.
